10. What are your personal strengths?
11. Tell me about a time when you had to deal with a conflict.
12. Explain how your previous work experience qualifies you for participation in the MYEP.
13. How would you handle an angry client or customer?
14. What are your weaknesses?
15. Please describe your work ethic.

The following questions received **one vote** each:

1. How do you react when you receive criticism?
2. What do you like to do in your spare time?
3. How do you feel about repetitive tasks?

4. Was there an occasion when you disagreed with a supervisor's/teacher's decision or policy? Describe how you handled the situation.
5. What is one negative thing your current or past teacher/supervisor would say about you?
6. What is one positive thing your current or past teacher/supervisor would say about you?
7. Tell me about a time when your work received hard criticism. How did you handle the feedback?
8. Give me an example of a situation that best demonstrates your ability to work well with a team of people.
9. You are given several important assignments that need to be completed as soon as possible. How do you establish priorities?
10. Describe your organizational abilities.
11. How quickly can you learn a new process or software?
12. How do you define success and failure?
